Our mission is in our name:

Through the kindness of volunteers and the generosity of many donors, the Mission of Deeds gives new beds, gently used home goods and furniture to people in need.

- Everything given to our clients is free of charge
- We service clients in over 80 communities in Massachusetts
- All household goods and furniture are donated, with the exception of beds which are funded by donations
- We pick up furniture donations in Reading and surrounding towns
- Clients are referred by over 200 social service agencies, religious organizations, schools or hospitals
- Mission of Deeds was founded in 1993 by Tony Triglione
- Since inception, we have helped over 10,000 families
- Mission of Deeds receives no federal, state or United Way funding and relies solely on donations from individuals, corporations and local organizations
- We have a regular volunteer corps of more than 150 people, with many more volunteering on special drives, projects and events
